# Emma - Zambia

I am always blessed to see how God arranges things to help his children and answer their prayers. Recently, I went to a community, I had never been to before. It has a Hands at Work Care point from which children are feed a daily nutritious meal and helped with basic health and educational support. Towards the end of the day we noticed a small child with a large and raw sore on the side of their neck. We found out that the child had been recently burned. We asked if we could visit the family and see if we could get the child back to the clinic for some more treatment.

On arrival at the small family hut, we could see both parents are struggling with their health. The child was burnt in an accident, and we made sure that the wound was treated well but our attention is quickly drawn to his mother, Mary.

Just by looking at her you could see she had a serious health issue. Mary shared her cancer diagnosis, how long it took to be eventually diagnosed and how hard it was for her to get treatment. Mary shared that she needed to go to Lusaka (some eight hours drive away) to receive more medication that she had now finished. Mary's review to return to the hospital was the day before our visit to her house. Mary shared that as soon as she could gather enough money together for the transport, she would go to Lusaka for more treatment.

For her last trip, she was able to go because she received money for transport from local pastors who helped her. This time a muzungu (white person) suddenly shows up with money in her purse and is able to help.

I can feel embarrassed about sharing such a story because it is so difficult being faced with abject poverty on a daily basis. I can't help everyone, it is not my job to rescue everyone, that belongs to the Lord. I know, however, that without doubt God arranged this visit and answered Mary's prayers, asking God to save her.

Pray for Mary's complete healing, her husband who has epilepsy and an eye condition, her youngest son (pictured) who has the burn, as well as two other sons not present.

God loves his children. He can send anyone to help you, just be aware that he may need to send you.
